RE: Water Licence Amendment

Aurora Energy Resources Inc. (Aurora) would like to request an amendment to water licence 2BE-KAZ0609. We request that the license be amended to allow open burning of untreated wood products under Part D Item 2. There will be no mineral exploration, the only the activity will be to reclamation the Bissett Lake Camp.

Aurora would also like an extension to the expiry date to allow us adequate time to carry out the Final Closure and Reclamation Plan. We plan to conduct the reclamation program before the 2010 winter season begins. However, we would like to add contingency time to the request just in case things do not go as planned and we need extra time. We request the expiry to be September 19, 2011.
