NPC File #148367 Kahuna Diamond Project

Thank you for your letter of November 9, 2016 confirming that the conformity determination issued April 28, 2015 and January 7, 2016 for NPC File No. 148166 still applies.

I am concerned that NPC has determined that Dunnedin's re-submission (NPC File #14367) is " a significant modification to the project because of an expanded scope of exploratory work", as this is not the case. In complying with the Assistant Deputy Minister's letter (received August 11, 2016) and in accordance with NIRB's recommendations (report by E. Copland dated April 4, 2016), Dunnedin modified its application by providing clarification, additional information (i.e. Consultation Log) and by completing an archaeological survey. *There is no "expanded scope of exploratory work"*. Exploratory work proposed in the resubmission is identical in scope to our original submission.

Denise Lockett who is coordinating our licencing and permitting has tried several times to contact you to discuss this misunderstanding, but unfortunately without success. I would like to organise a telephone call to discuss as soon as possible.
