The Fisheries Protection Program (the Program) of Fisheries and Oceans Canada received the new water licence application project for Kahuna Gold Project on November 7, 2018.

The Program has reviewed the Proponent's application pursuant to its mandate. At this time the Program does not have enough information to determine if the Project will result in serious harm. Additional information on the water bodies proposed to be used for water taking, as well as water volumes from each water body is required to complete the review of this project.
