Re: Amendment request to licence No 2BE-KIG0812, for an increase in water usage

As discussed earlier this week, please find the attached amendment request to increase the allowable water usage from 110 cubic meters per day to 300 cubic meters per day. Currently 5 cubic meters is utilized for camp usage and the remaining 105 cubic meters has been allotted for the drilling program.

The volumes requested in the application submitted in December 2008 where underestimated to accommodate the new types of rigs being utilized for the 2008 drilling program. The field program remains the same as original indicated, which is to conduct approximately 5000 metres of exploration drilling at the Bong and Granite area; 2,000 metres of feasibility drilling at Kiggavik and 7,000 metres at Sissons; in situ testing; groundwater sampling and the continuation of environmental baseline work (aquatic, terrestrial, wildlife, hyrodrogeological and hydrological assessments).

Due to current field conditions, water sources for the Bong and Granite areas have not yet been selected. As you suggested in our conversion, these water sources will be identified and discussed in the 2008 annual report.

Please note that the \$30 administration fee will be sent via mail and should arrive soon.
