The Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC) received a letter October 14, 2009 from Kim Sarauer of Areva Resources Canada Inc. inquiring whether or not a conformity determination to the Keewatin Regional Land Use Plan (KRLUP) is necessary for on ice geotechnical drilling at the proposed Thelon River Crossing as identified in the Kiggavik Project Proposal.
