Mr. Aglukark/ Ms. Payette,

On April 23, 2009 AREVA Resources Canada (AREVA) applied for an amendment to the Nunavut Water Board (NWB) licence #2BE-KIG0812 requesting that the camp water usage be increased to 10 m<sup>3</sup> per day from 5 m<sup>3</sup> per day and drill water usage decreased to 290 m<sup>3</sup> per day from 295 m<sup>3</sup> per day. The daily total limit of 300 m<sup>3</sup> would remain the same.

On April 30, 2009 the NWB requested that AREVA provide them with the following information before they process this amendment request:

- Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB) Screening Decision (or confirmation in writing that a NIRB screening is not required)
- Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC) Conformity (or confirmation in writing that an NPC Conformity is not required)

AREVA believes that the above amendment request does not change the original scope of the Project or conformity determination with the Keewatin Land Use Plan. Can you please confirm that AREVA's amendment request falls within the previous screening and conformity determination to allow for amendment processing by the NWB. For your convenience I have attached the amendment application submitted to the NWB, the NPC conformity determination received by AREVA in December 2006 and the NIRB Screening Decision (06AN085) originally received by AREVA in April 2007.

Please advise if this approach is sufficient to confirm applicability of previous decisions to amendment requests. Please do not hesitate to contact me should you have any questions or concerns.
