## Re: <u>AREVA Resources Canada Inc's amendment request to authorize on-ice geotechnical drilling</u>

Dear Diane Martens:

On October 13, 2009 the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB or Board) received AREVA Resources Canada Inc.'s (AREVA) amendment request to its Nunavut Water Board Licence (2BE-KIG0812) and to its Kivalliq Inuit Association Licence (KVL306C02). In the application, AREVA is requesting to amend the above licences to allow for the drilling of 10-12 geotechnical holes at the proposed Thelon River crossing as identified in the Kiggavik project proposal. Eight of the geotechnical holes are proposed to be drilled on-ice and are meant to gain a better understanding of the existing rock structure and therefore the bridge requirements for the proposed Kiggavik project.

Please be advised that this proposed activity was not included within the scope of NIRB's screening for AREVA's exploration program (NIRB File No. 06AN085). However, this activity is considered to be a component of AREVA's "Kiggavik" uranium mine project proposal. Specifically, in its March 13, 2009 Screening Decision Report for this project proposal<sup>1</sup>, the NIRB identified "works in and around water such as the construction of bridge crossings or cable-ferry/ice bridge crossing over the Thelon River" as an issue of concern that requires further attention, which would be best done through a full public review. As you may be aware, the NIRB is currently awaiting the Minister of Indian and Northern Affairs Canada's (INAC)

decision regarding the Board's recommendation that this project proposal undergo a review under Part 5 or Part 6 of the Nunavut Land Claims Agreement (NLCA).

At present, the Board is not able to provide a decision under Section 12.10.1 or Section 12.10.2 of the NLCA for this proposed activity without having a referral from the Minister of INAC for this file.
