This letter is to advice the regulatory agencies responsible for the Kiggavik Project regarding the status of the proposed bulk fuel storage tanks at the Project site. Although it was indicated in the applications for approvals for the 2008 field season, regrettably, due to a lack of available bulk fuel in the region, the Project will not be putting into use the bulk fuel storage tanks in 2008.

However, design, placement and use of the storage tanks will be conducted by a certified professional engineer, in accordance with *CCME Environmental Code of Practice for Aboveground and Underground Storage Tank Systems Containing Petroleum and Allied Petroleum Products*; regulatory recommendations and guidelines. All required information will be submitted prior to the commencing the use of these tanks. The use of drums will continue during the 2008 field season.
