## LICENCE AMENDMENT No. 3

Licensee: AREVA Resources Canada Inc. Licence No: 2BE-KIG0812 Type "B"

Licence Issued: April 25, 2008 Effective Date: July 27, 2009

Pursuant to its authority under Article 13 of the Agreement between the Inuit of the Nunavut Settlement Area and Her Majesty the Queen in Right of Canada and the Nunavut Waters and the Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act, the Nunavut Water Board hereby grants the following Licence amendment.

The Licence issued April 25, 2008 with an expiry date of December 31, 2012 shall be amended to include the following terms and conditions, with respect to use of water and deposit of waste during camp and drilling operations, to allow AREVA Resources Canada Inc. to use 10 m<sup>3</sup> of water per day for camp use and 290 m<sup>3</sup> per day for drilling operations at the Kiggavik/Sissons Project in the Kivalliq Region, based at the camp located at latitude 64°26'29"N and longitude 97°39'34"W.

## PART C: CONDITIONS APPLYING TO WATER USE

Amend Item 1

The Licensee shall obtain all water for domestic camp use from an unnamed lake approximately three hundred metres north of the camp, up to a maximum of ten (10) cubic metres *per* day. Drill water shall be obtained from local water source(s), proximal to the drilling targets, to a maximum of two-hundred and ninety (290) cubic metres *per* day. The volume of water for the purposes of this Licence shall not exceed three-hundred (300) cubic metres *per* day.

All remaining terms and conditions of the Licence 2BE-KIG0812 Type 'B" dated April 25, 2008 still apply.
