**Re: Utilization of a float plane on Pointer Lake, Nu**  
**INAC Land Use Permit #N2006C0037**  
**NWB Licence No 2BE-KIG0708**  
**KIA Land Use Licence KVL306C02**

During the week of July 9, 2007 a consulting biologist with Golder Associates discovered a potential heritage resource near an area currently being utilized by Areva Resources Canada Inc as a landing strip for the delivery of necessary supplies and personnel.

Use of this landing strip was immediately ceased and will not resume until a complete archaeological survey is completed and/or AREVA has received recommendations from the Department of Culture, Language, Elders and Youth.

This landing area is not located within AREVA's lease; but is located approximately 5 km west of the Kiggavik Project. Due to ceasing the use of this area, AREVA is proposing to initiate the use of a float plane to land on Pointer Lake. AREVA intends to utilize this method of delivery on an as needed, temporary basis. Pointer Lake was utilized in the 1970's and 1980's for delivering supplies and

personnel to the area, however was not included in AREVA's original project application due to receiving permission to utilize two nearby eskers for landing; therefore an amendment to the project application and approval from regulating agencies is required.

As the field season is relatively short, AREVA would appreciate a response to this manner as soon as possible.
