The Government of Nunavut, Department of Environment (DOE) has reviewed the Amendment Request for the Kiggavik project. Based on the *Environmental Protection Act*, the DOE has the following comments and recommendations to make.

If any drilling additives are used, the Proponent should ensure that they
are non-toxic and biodegradable and accompanied by MSDS sheets.
 Furthermore, sumps for drill cuttings should only be used for inert drill
cuttings, not any other materials or substances.
