AREVA Resources Canada for the Kiggavik Project**

Dear Stephanie Forseille:

The Nunavut Water Board (NWB or Board) has completed its review of the 2015 and 2016 Annual Reports (Reports) submitted by AREVA Resources Canada Inc., on January 28, 2016 and January 27, 2017, respectively, to fulfill relevant requirements in Licence No. 2BE-KIG1318 (Licence), issued to the Kiggavik Project, a uranium exploration project located approximately 80 kilometres west of Baker Lake in the Kivalliq Region, Nunavut. The review determined that the Reports are generally complete and consistent with the reporting requirements under Part B, Item 2 of the Licence. The review notes that no exploration activities were conducted during the 2016 field period and that the limited quantities of domestic waste generated during several site visits over the same period were backhauled to an approved facility for disposal.
