Dear Mr MacIsaac:

RE: Water Management during Exploration Activities at Kiggavik

As indicated by AREVA Resources Canada in the Project Proposal Information Requirements screened by NIRB and approved of by INAC (#N2006C0037) and KIA (#KVL306C02), current activities at the Kiggavik Sissons Project include the gathering of hydrogeological data.

AREVA is intending to conduct packer tests at the end of the 2007 field season (late September or early October), to gather hydrogeological data about the hydraulic conductivity of the bedrock below the permafrost at the Sissons site. The proposed test location is hole number ENDG-07-01 (End Grid area at Sissons), coordinates N 7135728 E 554286.

As recently discussed with Jim Rogers, Manager of Water Resources at INAC, it is anticipated that the packer tests will release a relatively limited quantity of clean surface water from the active layer, in the order of approximately 1 cubic meter.

AREVA will ensure that the engineering consultants conducting the testing (SRK Consulting) will direct any water released during testing to a low lying area for storage and sample collection. The water generated will be sampled in the field for pH and turbidity, as well as tested at a laboratory for anions, cations, metals and radionuclides.
