As per conditions associated with the above approvals for the Kiggavik Project, all Environmental Management Plans are reviewed on a regular basis and updates are provided with the submission of the annual report. In January 2008, a revision of the Wildlife Mitigation and Monitoring Plan was submitted for review and comment. However, due to the acquisition of a new consulting biologist and



recommendations made by other wildlife biologists working in the Territories; this Plan was revoked via email and telephone messages on April 24th, 2008 (Mark Warbanski, AREVA).
