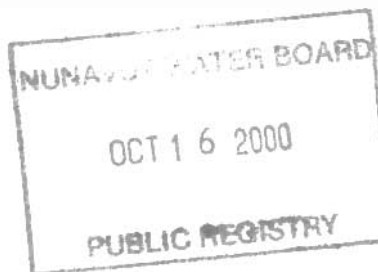

Rhonda Reports Macrodiamonds

Calgary, Alberta - Glen R. Alston, President, is very pleased to report the Knife kimberlite pipe contains macrodiamonds. The pipe was discovered this spring after De Beers was granted the right to investigate a geophysical target on one of Rhonda Corporation's Epworth property claims, 75 kilometres south of the Coronation Gulf in Nunavut. De Beers was able to drill three test holes before the drilling season ended.

Samples totalling 75kg from three intervals totalling 25m from the Knife Pipe Hole #1 have yielded 98 diamonds including 6 macrodiamonds. This initial sampling represents less than 6% of the total of 455m of kimberlite intersected in the three initial holes on the Knife pipe. Included in the initial results is one 20kg sample which yielded 54 diamonds including two 1mm macrodiamonds.

De Beers can earn a 70% interest in the Knife pipe property by expending \$10 million and carrying Rhonda to production.



Dear Judy,

Many thanks for your quick and positive response to Todd McKinlay's initial letter of March 30, 2000. In order to set the scene for my later comments it is perhaps appropriate to clarify that Monopros can see only a single target which falls on one of your currently held claims. Thus we would not contemplate work on any of the remaining claims and consequently any JV Agreement would not include exploration per se but be restricted to the investigation and possible development of the single target/kimberlite.

Turning to the points raised in your April 7'th letter: *(attachment 1)*

- Private placements - Monopros similarly has no interest in private placements at this time.
- Option payments - My preference is for no option payments being made in 2000. As Todd indicated the target appears small, it occurs off the Slave Craton senso-stricto, and the neighbouring (2) Kimberlites are essentially barren of diamonds. Essentially what we are proposing is a high risk drill programme and as such my preference is to keep expenditure to a minimum in this first phase of work.

- Points (2) to (6).

Re: Rhonda's mineral claims in the area of Kikerik Lake, Nunavut

Dear Mr. McKinlay:

In response to your facsimile dated March 30, 2000, Rhonda is interested in your proposed program and would be willing to discuss the terms of a joint venture. Please forward a copy of the proposed agreement to me and I will review it immediately (I note that you are considering a drill setup this spring).

The points that I am most concerned with are:

- 1 Option payments of 10% of work done per year. Rhonda would not be interested in private placements at this time.
- 2 The first \$250,000 spent would earn you 51%
- 3 Earn up to 70%, with expenditures totaling 10 million, over a stated period (6 years?)
- 4 Rhonda carried to production decision
- 5 If a resulting mine produces any other metal, same percentages at that time apply
- 6 Timely disclosure of all field results to Rhonda

These claims will be brought to lease in 2002 with the Esker Pb-Zn group, but I am always open to promoting any exploration activity possible. Please call me or Glen Alston if you have any questions.
