b) Drill holes Kik-04-010c and Kik-04-011c: N67 00 46.6 W113 09 07.1 (coordinates from 2004 annual report)									
c) Reported fuel cache: N67 00 46.0 W113 09 00.2 (coordinates from N97C753 Final Plan)									
Findings are as follows:									
1) Camp was not removed from location (a). Wooden debris remains, and some garbage has blown into the lake over time. 8									
full drums of P50 were found, one of which is beginning to leak, and one drum of gasoline was also present. The drums are									
marked as Debeers. The barrels are within 30m of the water, and with their age pose a risk of release. [Photos 1-5]									
2) No drill collars or casings were noted in the area where drilling occurred, however, timbers were strewn widely around.
