### Managers and supervisors (including contractors) are accountable for:

- Implementing effective emergency preparedness systems

- Work in a safe and healthy manner, keeping their workplace clean and orderly
- Ensure they are informed of, understand and comply with all applicable laws and De Beers policies, programmes and procedures

- Report immediately all incidents and accidents
