Reference: Water Licence Application, Mountain Lake Claims and Dismal Lake Permits

Please accept the enclosed Water Licence application for the exploration of uranium in the Mountain Lake claims and the Dismal Lake permits and claims within the Kitikmeot region, along with a cheque for \$150.00 (\$30.00 required fee and \$120.00 water use fee), supplementary questionnaire and summaries (English and translated) of the project.

We withdrew our original application upon learning that ours was the first application for the exploration of uranium in Nunavut for some time.
