**RE: WATER LICENCE RENEWAL AND AMENDMENT APPLICATION

Dear Phyllis Beaulieu;

Please accept the enclosed Water Licence renewal and amendment application for the exploration of uranium in the Mountain Lake Claims and the Dismal Lake Permits within the Kitikmeot region, along with the required fee (\$30.00), annual water use fee (\$30.00), supplementary questionnaire and project summary.

The amendment being requested is an increase in the daily allowable water volume for drilling. Currently Triex is permitted to use 15 cubic metres per day. We would like to operate two drills in the future and are requesting an increase to 60 cubic metres per day.

We began consultation efforts in Kugluktuk in May of 2005 holding meetings with the KIA and KHTA. Meetings continued throughout 2005 while Triex personnel were based in Kugluktuk. In 2006 a camp was established on Kirwan Lake. Consultation meetings were held in early October that same year. Project updates were provided at these meetings. In October 2007 Triex will again be travelling to Kugluktuk to give presentations on the project to date and to discuss the upcoming 2008 field season.
