RE: Annual Report Required for Kirwan Lake Project

Dear Anna North:

On February 7, 2007 the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB) received a new project proposal from Triex Minerals for the Mountain Lake Uranium Exploration Project. The project proposal was received from the Kitikmeot Inuit Association (KIA). On February 19, 2007 NIRB requested additional information from the Proponent, and on March 7, 2007 NIRB received the required information and commenced the Part 4 Screening. The NIRB completed its Screening Decision on April 3, 2007 assessing the project as a:

**12.4.4** (a) - the proposal may be processed without a review under Part 5 or 6; NIRB may recommend specific terms and conditions to be attached to any approval, reflecting the primary objectives set out in Section 12.2.5.

Term and Condition #7 of the Screening Decision Report recommended the following:

- 7. The Proponent shall submit an annual report with copies provided to the NIRB and the KIA by January 31 each year that the project is in operation commencing January 31, 2008. The report must contain, but not be limited to, the following information:
  - a. A summary of activities undertaken for the year and a work plan for the following year;
  - b. The results of any environmental studies undertaken and plans for future studies;
  - c. Wildlife sightings, mitigation measures, and monitoring results;
  - d. A discussion regarding the effects to human health from uranium exploration activities;
  - e. A summary of local hires and community consultations undertaken;
  - f. A summary of site-visits by Land Use Inspectors with results and follow-up actions;
  - g. The number of take-offs & landings from an airstrip with approved flight path with date and location:

- i. Site photos;
- j. Progressive reclamation work undertaken;
- k. Efforts made to achieve compliance with the Canadian Wide Standards for Dioxins and Furans, and the Canadian Wide Standards for Mercury; and
- 1. A summary of how the Proponent has complied with NIRB conditions contained within this Screening Decision, and the conditions associated with all authorizations for the project proposal.

The NIRB is aware that Triex Minerals Corp. has submitted a 2008 annual report to the Nunavut Water Board on June 2, 2009 in accordance with the provisions of license 2BE-KIR0812. The Board notes the similarities in much of the information requirements, and suggests this report could be modified to meet the requirements of the NIRB Screening Decision as follows:

- Wildlife sightings, mitigation measures, and monitoring results; please submit wildlife records.
- A discussion regarding the effects to human health from uranium exploration activities; **please** indicate studies undertaken or safety discussions concerning uranium exploration.
- A summary of local hires and community consultations undertaken; please provide a list of either activity.
- The number of take-offs & landings from an airstrip with approved flight path with date and location; please provide take-off/landing schedules for any non-municipal airstrip.
- The number of helicopter touch-downs on the land with date and location (provide unless

- Site photos; please provide drill and camp site photos.
- Efforts made to achieve compliance with the Canadian Wide Standards for Dioxins and Furans, and the Canadian Wide Standards for Mercury; please provide proof of compliance or protocols outlining incinerator usage.
- A summary of how the Proponent has complied with NIRB conditions contained within this Screening Decision, and the conditions associated with all authorizations for the project proposal; please detail any further compliance to the NIRB screening decision terms and conditions.

The NIRB is requesting submission of the above information in the required annual report by August 31, 2009.
