This is in reference to the Kirwan Lake Project, the 2008 Annual Report filed by Triex and dated June 2, 2009, and the subsequent NIRB review comments, including requests for additional information, dated August 17, 2009. This letter covers the final work done for the complete clean-up of the temporary exploration camp at Kirwan Lake, northwestern Nunavut, and provides NIRB with the requested information.

As per electronic messages (e-mail) to INAC dated June 10 and July 21, 2009, the camp clean-up program was planned for late June. However, because of the unseasonably late break-up of lake ice, the area was not open until late July, such that despite our best efforts, Triex was not able to re-schedule the clean-up until August.

The clean-up program was extensive, taking ten days to complete, and at considerable cost, of just under \$200,000. It was completed on August 18. A field report including photographs was completed by August 31st. That report is attached to this cover, and is the principal amendment the Company's 2008 Annual Report previously sent to NIRB on June 2, 2009. Preceding the report is a summary internal company memo.

Also attached to this cover is an Amendment/Attachment to the 2008 Annual Report, containing the information requested in the NIRB review dated August 17, 2009.

Under difficult spring conditions, please accept our best efforts to complete the final clean-up of the Kirwan Lake camp as soon as it was physically possible to do so. And please accept our efforts to turn around a thorough documentation of the clean-up program as quickly as possible. Overall, the attached field report, and the overall extent and cost of the program, are respectfully submitted as a reflection of our commitment to best practices regarding full and complete clean-up of temporary exploration campsites.
