Good morning Tanis

Further to my telecon with you this morning here is the history of the file - In January 2011 Guyana Precious Metals Inc. applied for a "new" water licence. Our office distributed the file for review in March 2011 and INAC advised during the review period that they required additional time to assess the file. The extension was granted in order for INAC to determine if Guyana, in actual fact, were authorized to set up operations on this particular site. It appears that Coronation Minerals was the initial company working the same project area under licence 2BE-KUG0810, NIRB screening 08EN022. It came to light that there was no change of name provided to the Nunavut Water Board when the company changed their name in 2009. We now have on file those Articles of Amendment. This file should have actually been a renewal to 2BE-KUG0810 instead of a new application under the file number of 2BE-DIS----.

On January 31, 2011 NIRB provided our office with a "Pending Referral" letter which was mistakenly considered in our office as a screening decision. Consequently NIRB still has the file on hold for an authorizing agency.

By way of this email the Nunavut Water Board is hereby requesting NIRB review the file to confirm whether or not the screening decision (08EN022) dated April 2008 for Coronation Minerals Inc. still applies. Subsequently our office will ensure that the 2 files are cross referenced for future identification.
