Project Comments - Coppercorp Inc. - Dismal Lake Area

This application is quite different from most we review in that the proponent plans daily travel to the drill sites from a community; thereby avoiding the issue of erecting a camp.

This should allow the proponent to pick up easily with the one comment I have about the application. It seems to me that the Dismal Lake area receives significant active use by traditional harvesters of Kugluktuk. There are several cabins located in this area and it is a traditionally sensitive area. Accordingly, I would encourage the proponent to communicate fully and directly his intentions with this exploratory process with the local Community Council and with the Kugluktuk Angonaitit Association (HTO).

This consultation could include an initial analysis of what they intend to do and for how long this year and how they intend to involve local resources and expertise. They could also provide a season end follow-up report or meeting advising of project success and problems. Thus way the community will feel a part of the process and more likely to support the ongoing initiative if everything regarding this work is "up front".

Otherwise, I have no additional concerns with the project as described.
