The Kitikmeot Inuit Association (KIA) has reviewed the submitted documents and information regarding Guyana Precious Metals Inc.'s Dismal Lake project.

KIA is currently holding payment for a Class III Land Use License pending additional information from Guyana Precious Metals. A license will not be issued until such information is provided and assessed.

KIA would also like to be notified immediately if an environmental or safety event occurs on Inuit Owned Land. KIA would encourage Guyana Precious Metals to (1) hire local Inuit for the project, and (2) inform local communities of project developments.
