Technical Review Memorandum

Re: 2BE-LEP1217 - Lupin Mines Incorporated – Lupin Exploration Project - Amendment No. 2 Application

A. Background

On January 25, 2012, Lupin Mining Incorporated (a subsidiary of Elgin Mining Incorporated) was issued water licence 2BE-LEP1217 for water use and waste disposal associated with the Lupin Exploration Project, an exploration program to investigate targets surrounding the Lupin Mine site. LMI submitted an application to amend its water licence to increase water use from 45 to 240 m³ / day for drilling purposes which was approved by the NWB on June 11, 2012.

On July 19, the NWB distributed LMI's application for a second amendment to water licence 2BE-LEP1217 to include 4 additional mineral claims and one additional mining lease. No changes associated with camp use, operation schedule, water use, or waste disposal are proposed.

B. Results

AANDC notes that the purpose of the application to amend water licence 2BE-LEP1217 is to expand the surface exploration area. Since there are no changes to water use or waste deposition associated with water licence 2BE-LEP1217, AANDC have no issues or concerns with this amendment application. AANDC offers the following comments / recommendations for the NWB's consideration.

- AANDC recommends that all conditions in the water licence 2BE-LEP1217 apply to the expanded exploration area.
- The application indicates that there are no proposed changes to water use or waste disposal (Block 9). However, AANDC notes that there is a change in the source of water (new water sources and sumps proximal to new drilling targets within the expanded area). AANDC expects GPS coordinates for all locations where water is used and waste is deposited within the Lupin Exploration Project area to be submitted to the NWB in the annual report.
