May 22, 2014 North Arrow met with Hamlet Council and HTO (the mayor, two councilors and two members of the HTO. The main concern was the impact on caribou created by the helicopter flights. We discussed caribou disturbance mitigation strategies such as altering flight patterns and delaying flights to allow caribou to move out of the work area.  Attempted to get back for full community, council and HTO November 17, 2015 but weather prevented it. Have agreed to complete meetings before drilling commences.
