We have an early stage project located about 60 northwest of Chesterfield Inlet called the Luxx Project and we would like the opportunity to come to your community to meet with the Mayor, Harry Aggark and Council to introduce ourselves and to discuss the property. We are visiting the community of Repulse Bay on the Tuesday and Wednesday, May 22nd and 23rd and would be arriving in Chesterfield Inlet on Thursday, May 24th on the afternoon flight from Rankin Inlet, assuming you are available for a meeting.  There is a kimberlite indicator anomaly on the property that suggests diamonds may be present in the source kimberlite (the source rock for diamonds). We would like to come this summer once the snow is gone to have a walk around to see if we can find any evidence of this kimberlite on the surface. We will also be submitting a request for a drilling permit in the nearer-term in case kimberlite is not found at surface this summer and drilling is required to locate it.  If we did receive the permit and move ahead to the drilling stage for this anomaly at the Luxx Project we would not build a camp for the work. We would be working out of Chesterfield Inlet and it would be a pretty short program, probably around a week to two weeks or so.
