RE: Cancellation of type B Water Licence No: 2BE-LUX2025 issued to North Arrow Minerals Inc. for the Luxx Project

Dear Mike MacMorran:

On October 31, 2023, the Board received an application to cancel the type B Water Licence 2BE-LUX2025. On November 07, 2024, the Board provided a Notice as per s.55 (1) *Nunavut Waters and Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act* (Act)¹ and distributed the application for thirty (30) day comment period. Before the deadline for comments, a submission was received from Crown-Indigenous Relations and Northern Affairs (CIRNA).

CIRNA stated that they had made one recommendation in the comment period invitation, dated 12 November, 2024.

1. Crown-Indigenous Relations and Northern Affairs Canada (CIRNAC) examined the application pursuant to its mandated responsibilities under the *Nunavut Waters and Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act* and the *Department of Crown-Indigenous Relations and Northern Affairs Act*. CIRNAC recommends that the board ensure no outstanding fees are owed before cancelling the licence.

Upon review of all information, the Nunavut Water Board (NWB) determined that the application fulfills the requirements of s. 43(1)(c) of Act² and NWB Guide 7³. The NWB has, therefore, approved the cancellation of Water Licence 2BE-LUX2025 through Board Motion No. 2024-B1-015, dated January 10, 2025.

¹ The Board shall give notice of every application in relation to a licence to the council of each municipality in the area affected by the application and shall publish the notice in a newspaper of general circulation in the area affected or, if there is no such newspaper, in such other manner as the Board considers appropriate.

² The s. 43(1)(c) indicates when the Board may cancel a licence.

³ The minimum information requirements set out in the NWB Guidance Document- *Guide 7 – Licensee Requirements Following the Issuance of a Water Licence*, April 2010, see Part 11 and Table 4.
