I'm going through the file on the 5050 limited (Adriana) application for the McGregor Lake Project (MIE) and have a couple questions that you might be able to answer for me.

The application and the questionnaire both refer to a water use for drilling of 132.49m3 (for the drill program). I'm unsure if this is just for this season, or for the three seasons the licence has been applied for. Generally, we don't go to the extent of putting a maximum overall volume in the licences, it is based on an estimated consumption per day. Would you have an idea what the consumption per day would be (total, for however many drills the company may be operating), eg. 15 m3/day.

My second question has to do with the land status. The questionnaire and the application differ in what is in place or applied for. One says DIAND, the other says KIA? The application describes the land as KIA, however the check boxes are for DIAND. From the map I have it appears that it should all be on IOL?
