Having taken a moment to review the situation, I wish to express that in the case of License No. 2BE-MCG0810 and No. 2007X0043, I wish to pose a question whereby these two licenses were originally awarded to 5050 Nunavut Limited to whom the owner and contact person was Gordon Addie, President. At that time, Adriana Resources Inc. had ties on a corporate level but not on the 5050 Nunavut Limited level. Also, during that time, MIE Metals Corporation existed as a company owned by Gordon Addie.

Due to reasons outside of the scope of this email, Gordon Addie, MIE Metals Corporation, and 5050 Nunavut Limited separated from Adriana Resources Inc. No actual sale took place and no name change took place. As of today, Gordon Addie remains the owner of both 5050 Nunavut Limited and MIE Metals Corporation. For financial reasons, Gordon Addie has made 5050 Nunavut Limited a subsidiary of MIE Metals Corporation.

Given this information, is it still worthwhile that we proceed as per your email? At the end of the day, ownership has always been with Gordon Addie and 5050 Nunavut Limited. I know it is a bit "messy". Please advise. Thank you.

If there has been: "A sale or other disposition by a licensee of any right, title or interest in an appurtenant undertaking constitutes, subject to the authorization of the Board, an assignment of the licence to the person to whom the sale or other disposition is made."
