

**July 24, 2000 Water Licence Inspection - Report**

Firstly, I wish to thank Alan Sexton for the much appreciated time and assistance provided during the tour of the campsite. Attached for your records is the Industrial Water Use Inspection Report pertaining to the July 24, 2000 inspection; generally, the camp is well-kept and appears efficiently managed. Nonetheless, the following considerations were noted:

- **Water Supply:** Water consumption is estimated according to the capacity of camp storage tanks and the amount of active drills. Accordingly, the Permittee assured that a record of the approximated water usage would be provided to the Inspector and/or Nunavut Water Board. In parallel, the Inspector supports the Permittee's plan to install flow gauging devices on water intake lines.
- **Greywater disposal:** At the time of the inspection, the greywater sump (figure 1) did not appear to contain all greywater discharged and ensure that drainage is away from any water body, as per permit conditions (Part 3, Item 6). This being said, the Inspector trusts that the Permittee will be able to address this minor concern without much difficulty.
- **Fuel storage:** The Inspector wishes to commend the Permittee for its conscientious approach to fuel storage. Indeed, both the housing units fuel supply system (figure 2) and the bulk fuel storage site (figure 3) constitute above average practices in northern exploration camps.
