Subject: Submitted Waste Rock and Ore Storage Management Plan as per Part E, Item 6 of Licence 2BB-MEL0709 issued February 23, 2007 and Amended July 31, 2007

Dear Mr. Balog:

The Nunavut Water Board (“NWB”) would like to acknowledge receipt on August 31, 2007 of the above document submitted under Part E, Item 6 of Licence 2BB-MEL0709. The document was distributed on September 14, 2007 for review to interested persons and comments were received on the plan from Indian and Northern Affairs Canada. The NWB recommends that these comments be reviewed by the Licensee.

After completion of a technical review of the Ore Storage Management Plan, the document was found to generally meet the requirements set out in the Licence and is hereby accepted and approved under **Motion 2008-10-L02**. The Licensee shall submit, within sixty (60) days of the date of this approval letter, an addendum to the plan addressing the following issues:

1. An explanation of what tests and test methods were carried out to measure acid potential and neutralization potential, who performed those tests and the results of those tests;
2. An explanation of what tests and test methods were carried out to measure metal leaching potential, who performed those tests and the results of those tests;
3. Identification of the limits used to decide what rocks are considered safe for road construction and pad construction;
4. Explanation of why waste rock was considered to be a modest risk of acid generation;
5. What parameters are being measured in the waste rock pad run-off and how often tests are to be taken;
6. A schedule for waste rock pad inspection, who is to perform the inspection and what the inspection involves; and
7. Submission of as built design drawings for the ore and waste rock storage plans including a cross section of the waste rock and ore storage berms and base.
