Re: NWB2MEL0103 – Fuel Contingency Plans and Environmental Management

Dear Mr. Sexton:

The Nunavut Water Board has granted conditional approved the report titled, “**Fuel Contingency Plans and Environmental Management**”, received April 25, 2001 by WMC International Ltd. in compliance with Part G, Item 2 of their current water licence. In general WMC International Plan needs to be more focused on the contingency aspect of environmental management by segregating the environmental management into a separate plan. Although information of the Nunavut Land Claim Agreement and land management is interesting, the information necessary to take precautions, prevent, manage and mitigate environment impact, including environmental management team, is more important for a contingency plan.

Please resubmit a revised plan to the NWB within thirty (30) days, in which the following provisions are included:

- Ensure that the focus and contents of the plan are in accordance with the NWT water Board’s “Guidelines for Contingency Planning” of January 1987;
- Include a site map of hazardous materials storage and location of spill kits are submitted for the camp;
- Include a NWT spill report form;
- Ensure the notifications of inspectors as a part of the spill response; and,
- Ensure the information within the plan is relevant, user friendly and clear.
