Re: Application for Renewal of Water License 2BE-MLL1217

Dear Ms. Porter,

Sabina Gold & Silver Corp. (Sabina) would like to request a renewal and extension to water license 2BE-MLL1217 for the Wishbone-Malley Project (the Project), Kitikmeot Region, Nunavut. Sabina is requesting a renewal of the license for a further five years from March 27th, 2017 to March 26th, 2022. A completed renewal application form is included as Attachment 1. A map showing the Project location is included as Attachment 2.

Scope of Activities Proposed Under the Water License Renewal

The renewal does not represent a change in scope for the Project. All activities as currently defined will be consistent with the activities undertaken in previous years and consistent with current authorizations.

Attachment 3 is email correspondence from the Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC) dated December 4th, 2011 confirming that the Project Proposal lies outside a planning region with an approved regional land use plan.

The first Type B Water Licence 2BE-MLL1217 for the Wishbone-Malley Project was issued in 2012. A consolidated screening of all Dundee Precious Metals Inc.'s holdings in the Beechy Lake area (inclusive of the Back River and Wishbone claim areas) was completed in 2008 under NIRB File 08EA084 (see reference to this on page 2 of the August 5, 2010 screening exemption decision by the NIRB, included as Attachment 4).

Compliance Assessment / Status Reports

The Wishbone-Malley Project was visited by the INAC Land Use Inspector in August, 2016. The inspection report (Attachment 5) did not record any issues of non-compliance.



Current Management Plans

Sabina's current environmental management plans in place for the Wishbone-Malley Project are listed in Table 1 and included as Attachments 8 – 11.
