I understand that the Mouse Lake Project Camp has been dismantled. If Horby Bay Mineral Exploration Ltd, does not have intention to resume activities under this Licence, I would recommend to apply for a licence cancellation.

The main benefit, from my point of view in applying for a licence cancellation would be that a final inspection will be carried out by INAC; . INAC' Inspector report will corroborate the status of the field. And also the file will be closed by the NWB at the moment of the cancellation, rather than after 4 years.

In order to apply for a Licence cancellation, you have to submit to the Board the Application for cancellation (attached) and \$30 Application fee.
