I have conducted a preliminary technical review on your application for renewal and amendment of the Mouse Lake Project. One item worth not is that a signed application form is required prior to processing the application. Also, the following issues should be addressed prior to a public review:

- 1. The application currently requests an expiry date of October 31, 2011. If exploration is anticipated for a longer term, would Unor Inc. prefer a longer term Licence such as 5 years?
- 2. For Unor Inc's. information, more recent Licenses require for camps with greater than 300 person days per year or greater than 1,000 person days for the life of the camp, disposing of sewage in a latrine pit is no longer permitted. Other options such as incineration, chemical or composting toilets remain viable.
