2) Last year, also due to the difficulty of raising capital in the wake of the Fukushima disaster, we were not able to open our camp and conduct any exploration activity on our Mouse Lake project. In such a situation do we still have to file a report for last year, since there is no new information to report?

Good day Bogdan – you are currently up to date on fees owing and we will not be requesting any additional fees over and above the \$30.00 already paid for 2011. On May 4, 2012 your payment will be due again and it would be for the \$237.25 as the calculator shows. The licences are issued for a set number of years, not portions thereof so the fees would be for the full year. It is my belief that if an applicant is only

going to operate for a specific number of months they would have already calculated the amount of water they would need to use for the time they are on site and the authorized amount is calculated on that basis. I trust this information is helpful.

Dear Ms. Beaulieu,

Regarding the calculation of the water use fees:

Hornby Bay Mineral Exploration Ltd. has already paid the water use fee for 2011 of \$30 as specified in its license 2BE-MOU0914. According to the calculator provided in your email, given that the amount allowed is 65 cubic meters per day, the fee should be \$237.25 for each year. I have the following questions:

- 1) Should we actually pay only for the number of days we operate in a single year, above the flat fee of \$30, since we are a seasonal operator and we cannot carry out exploration activities all year long? In such a case we would know only after the end of the field season how many days we operated in a given year.
- 2) However, if we are required to pay for the 365 days, please specify if for the current year the amount is pro-rated, given the fact that as the letter indicates the new calculation of fees is implemented starting June 20th. In such a case should we calculate only for the remaining days of the year starting June 20th?
