The Management of Hornby Bay Mineral Exploration Ltd. is giving notice that a decision has been made to suspend plans to conduct a seismic program on the Coppermine Property this spring due to obvious reasons related to timing, as well as the drastic reversal of the uranium markets worldwide, following the tragic situation in Japan. Depending on the evolution of the situation, we may be able to re-consider these plans for the fall of 2011, following freeze-up, or for the spring of 2012, before the break-up, as initially planned for the spring of this year.
