SECTION 1	Comments (s)	Non-Compliance with Act or Licence (s)	Action Required (s

An inspection of water licence no. 2BE-MPM2126 was completed by Crown-Indigenous Relations and Northern Affairs Canada (CIRNAC)'s, Water Resource Officer, Christine Wilson (Inspector). The inspection was conducted to ensure compliance with applicable terms and conditions of the water licence.

Preliminary Notes

- The Meadowbank Precious Metals Property (property) borders the Meadowbank Mine to the North and South.
- The Licensee utilizes accommodation facilities in Baker Lake. An amendment renewal water licence was approved by the Nunavut Water Board in 2021. The amendment included the construction of a 20 person (with capacity to expand to 40 person) camp. The proposed camp location is along the Meadowbank Mine's All Weather Access Road at kilometer 58 (approximately N64° 44' 32.75", W96° 21' 03.06").
- In 2019 13 holes were drilled on the property, all of which are located on crown land.
- The 2021 annual report was submitted as required by Part B item 2.
- The week prior to the date of inspection Baker Lake experienced a number of days with precipitation. A lot of surface water was observed in locations that are generally dry.

Observations

1. The following drill sites have been inspected;

Drill site	Location	Observations
WA1A	N64° 42' 02.0" W96° 01' 50.0"	No concern, cuttings in a isolated location.
WA2	N64° 42' 49.0" W96° 00' 31.0"	Cuttings in a isolated location. Collar still in place.
WA4	N64° 41' 37.0" W96° 06' 36.0"	No concern.
WA5	N64° 41' 56.0" W96° 04' 29.0"	Collar still in place. Site in a low lying area with a lot of water near the drill collar.

- 2. The collar is still in place at drill sites WA2 and WA5. The collar either needs to be removed or cut off at grade as required by Part I item 10.
- 3. The placement of the cuttings at drill site WA5 is concerning. The drill site appears to be located in the natural drainage path of nearby lake. Though the drill site is over 31 meters from the natural high water mark of the lake the cuttings could migrate from this location into the lake.

Instances of non-compliance related to the terms and conditions of water licence no. 2BE-MPM2126:

- PART F item 2: concern related to the placement of cutting into a natural depression or properly constructed sump over
 31 meters from the ordinary high water mark of the adjacent water body.
- PART H item 3: concern related to deposit of a waste in a place which may enter water.
- PART I item 10: Failure to reclaim drill sites immediately upon completion of drilling.
