This email is to to notify the Indigenous and Northern Affairs Canada ("INAC") and the Nunavut Water Board ("NWB") that Western Atlas Resources will be commencing an induced polarization (IP) survey over selected areas of the Company's Block B (part of the Meadowbank project), located in Meadowbank. The program is expected to start on August 15, 2018 and will last approximately 20 days. The survey will not involve the construction of any permanent structure or camp. All the team is currently based in Baker Lake. If there are any significant changes to our field work program we will notify you.

Also, please note that 5530 Nunavut Inc. is a wholly owned subsidiary of Western Atlas Resources.

All operations will adhere to conditions specified in the INAC Land Use Permit ("LUP") Number N2017C0005, and the Nunavut Water Board Water ("NWB") Licence Number 2BE-MPM1722.
