### Comment(s)

In Table 2 of the Spill Contingency Plan, the Proponent lists two incorrect phone numbers for ECCC: (867) 920-8130 and (867) 766-3737. The number (867) 910-8130 is the NWT/NU 24-Hour Spill Report Line, which is not an ECCC phone number.



The NWT/NU 24-Hour Spill Report Line should be contacted first by the Proponent. The NWT/NU Spill Report Line will then involve ECCC Emergencies when appropriate.

## ECCC Recommendation(s)

ECCC recommends that the Proponent:

- Remove the Environment and Climate Change Canada 24 hour number ([867] 766-3737) from the Spill Contingency Plan.
- Remove the reference to ECCC and update the contact name for the number ([867] 920-8130) to the NWT/NU 24-Hour Spill Response Line.
