

NON-TECHNICAL SUMMARY – Marce Project

Anconia Resources Corporation is a junior exploration company based in Toronto, ON and is publicly traded on the TSX Venture Exchange under the symbol ARA.

The purpose of Anconia's activities is to evaluate the Marce Project at Victory Lake for base and precious metals including copper, lead, zinc, silver and gold. The Project is in the Kivalliq Region of Nunavut, 167 kilometres North and West of Whale Cove, 190 kilometres South of Baker Lake and 180 kilometres West of Rankin Inlet. The project currently consists of 10 mineral claims on Inuit Owned Surface Land and 3 mineral claims on Crown Land.

In 2011 following initial staking, a preliminary mapping and sampling program was undertaken which was followed up with an airborne geophysical and electro-magnetic survey.

Plans for 2012 include establishing a small temporary camp for additional mapping, sampling and ground geophysics. Exploration activities are "results-driven" and as such, if positive results are obtained, Anconia would like to have a one drill utilized. Transportation will be by chartered fixed wing and helicopter.

Anconia Resources has applied for a Land Use Permit from the Kivalliq Inuit Association in May 2011, as well as a screening by NIRB and has received a positive conformity analysis by NPC. A Land Use Permit is also being applied for with Aboriginal Affairs and Northern Development Canada (AANDC).

Anconia will ensure that there is minimal disturbance to wildlife and they do not foresee any impact on the environment, water quality and climate during this program and is dedicated to exploring in an environmentally and socially responsible manner.

Community engagement visits are planned and welcomed to learn first hand the issues and concerns of local people. It is anticipated that modest employment and business opportunities may be extended once more is known about any possible resource on the exploration property.
