SECTION 1 Comments Non-Compliance with Act or Licence Action Required

Land Use Permit no. N2012C0006 is issued to Anconia Resources ('the permittee') for the use of land related to exploration of the Victory Project, Atlas Claims ('the project').

Preliminary notes

- In September 2013 a letter was issued by AANDC to the permittee (see appendix no. 2) regarding multiple failures to comply with the recently issued land use permit.
- The project is in a state of temporary closure since 2014.
- A laydown/storage area was established North of Victory Lake (see appendix no. 4)
- No camp or other undertakings are currently associated with this permit.
- The permittee was using a local commercial fishing lodge at Quartzite as a camp.

Observation

- 1. Zac Laydown/storage area is approximately located at N62° 40′ 16.5″, W95° 28′ 38.6″ (see photo 3).
- 2. The materials are not secured- debris from the storage site has becoming wind-blown.
- 3. The laydown is located on durable ground. No concerned related to rutting or surface drainage.
- 4. It is uncertain the total volume of fuel stored at the site because of the limited access to some of the drums. A total of three (3) full drums of fuel and a number of partial drums were confirmed.
- 5. There are twenty (20) plus empty fuel drums (see photo 2).
- 6. Many of the drums appear to be expired, with a date of 2009 on the labels (see photo 4).
- 7. There is no secondary containment for any of the hazardous waste, fuel or chemicals (see photo 1 and photo 6).
- 8. A number of containers of engine fluids are accessible to wildlife (see photo 6). The fluids are of great concern because of the attractive qualities the sweet taste of anti-freeze.
- 9. All the fuel drums are well labelled with the name 'Minroc Management' (see photo 4).
- 10. The permittee appears to have prepared majority of the materials for demobilization.
- 11. Some of the other materials include, drilling ancillary, drilling shack, bags of calcium chloride, one (1) water and two (2) fuel tanks fourteen (14) plus propage cylinders, containers of oil/grease/coolant, and wooden pallets (see photo 1)


