 An inspection of Anconia Resources Corporation's ('Anconia'), Marce Project was completed by Crown-Indigenous Relations and Northern Affairs Canada's, Resource Management Officer, Christine Wilson ('Inspector'). The inspection was conducted to ensure compliance with applicable terms and conditions of water licence no. 2BE-MRC1217. The following report was produced with observations noted by the Inspector at the Zak laydown located generally N62° 40′ 15.73″, W95° 28′ 35.33″and information provided by Anconia on October 28th (appendix 1). PRELIMINARY INFORMATION The Marce Project has been in a state of demobilization since 2016. Only materials stored at the Zak laydown authorized under the crown land use permit no. N2012C0006 remains to be clean-up. The 2019 clean-up was not completed as anticipated, and for that reason Anconia was granted a short term storage authorization under the Territorial Lands Use Regulations by Crown Indigenous Relations and Northern Affairs. In 2020-2021 the clean-up of the Zak laydown was finalized by a contractor on behalf of Anconia. 			
 OBSERVATIONS The materials located at the laydown have been removed; all the clean wood burned and ash backhauled (photo 1 and photo 2). Numerous locations of windblown garbage is noted around the laydown (photo 3- photo 7). Materials as follows; three tarps, an oil jug, metal siding, a small secondary containment berm and insulation. Three empty red and yellow drums (photo 8) are at the end of the airstrip at N62° 40′ 9.5″, W95° 29′ 5.6″. Two drill holes at the West end of the air strip require removal or to be cut off at ground level. Locations are listed as follows:

— On October 24th, the Permittee's contractor returned to the Zak laydown and completed an extensive clean-up.

— On October 28 th pictures of all the materials removed (appendix 2) including the locations of five reclaimed drill sites were		
provided to the Inspector by the Permittee's contractor.		
Upon review of the information provided by the Permittee's contractor, the Inspector has determined this will be a final inspection		
of the Marce (Zak laydown) project by Field Operations.





























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
