Dear Mr. Brewster and Mr. Newton:

The Nunavut Water Board (NWB or Board) has completed a technical review of the 2014, 2015, and 2016 Annual Reports for Water Licence No. 2BE-MRC1217.

On February 27, 2019, the NWB acknowledged receipt of the Annual Reports and made them available to the Kivalliq distribution list for information. No comments have been received to date.

The technical review of the Annual Reports determined that the information provided generally addresses the requirements of the Water Licence. The Board appreciates indication that no work has been done on site since Fall 2013 and, therefore, no Water use or Waste deposit occurred during the reported years.

The Board notes that the Licence has expired on April 15, 2017 and recommends submitting an application for Licence renewal if the Licensee intend to do some further work on Marce Project.

The NWB strongly recommends that the Licensee address all deficiencies identified in 2016 by the Inspector¹. The Board would like to remind the Licensee that the expiry or cancellation of the Licence does not relieve the holder from any obligations imposed by the Licence.
