This is to apply for an extension of the expiry date of the above land use Licence to 2014.

A lot has changed since I contacted you. Originally Coastal Gold has a friendly takeover offer. This would have resulted in all of the same players involved. However due to market events Coastal Gold is likely to be sold to a company called First Mining Corp. This of course is subject to shareholder approval but it is highly unlikely the deal will be opposed.

In the transaction Coastal Gold noted a liability amount for the reclamation of Maguse Lake. In that regard I am proceeding with the application as Coastal Gold is still in existence. I am also in the process of contacting First Mining Corp to make them aware of the plans we had for Maguse Lake this summer.

I will keep you fully informed of any developments and expect I will know more about this at latest next week.
