My apologies -I just noticed that the deadline for commenting on BIMC's Type B renewal application has passed – I was focussed on other things and thought it was tomorrow. Given the reduced scope of the BIMC proposal (as indicated by their letter to NIRB dated 140211) the only substantive comment EC would have made is that the proposed 25 year term for the Water licence was too long. EC is of the opinion that the term of the licence should be limited to 10 – 12 years to allow for the an assessment of whether licence terms and conditions have been effective and to determine if any adjustment is required.
