Hi Phyllis - I apologize for the slow response - I was working on behalf of Silvermet Inc. and am dependent on their direction to proceed or not. In June 2010 Silvermet had made arrangements to clean up and remove the camp, without the need to burn anything, through an alternate company. At the time Silvermet wished Aurora to limit its involvement in the process as they planned to complete it themselves. I will contact the Silvermet representative next week and find out what has happened over the summer, if they are still working towards the permit I will direct them to contact you.
