I am currently engaged in the planning and development of the 2014 field inspection schedule. While it is too early to predict the exact date, I hope to be in the Kivalliq Region and conducting inspections starting on July 3, 2014 with your inspections scheduled for **July 9, 2014**:

I will be attending the site to conduct inspections on the water use and disposal, waste management and other related water license issues.

I am requesting assistance in preparing for the inspection. If possible I would like to know the following information:

- Names and positions of staff associated with this project
- Confirmation of exact coordinates (degrees/min/sec, NAD 83) of activities (i.e.: fuel caches, camp, and drill locations).
- Any other information you feel is pertinent for a site visit (i.e.: recent activities, current plans, site hazards or restrictions, site safety protocols, etc.).
- Land use permit (LUP) numbers which are associated with this particular site
- Outstanding documents or documents recently submitted to the Nunavut Water Board (i.e.: within the last 60 days)
- A notice sent to the Nunavut Water Board that clarifies the relationship between Terrane Metals Corporation and Thompson Creek Metals Company.

I remind you that your current water licence is expired; however, the expiry of this authorization does not absolve the Licensee of the terms and conditions found within the License.

Please respond to this request within 15 days. Failure to undertake the actions required as described in this letter, and to the satisfaction of the Inspector, may result in enforcement action(s) being undertaken pursuant to the *Nunavut Waters and Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act*.

I look forward to our visit and hope we have the opportunity to work cooperatively together this coming year.
