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USING AN IRIDIUM 9505A SATELLITE PHONE

1	Rotate Antenna so that it will be vertical when it is placed to your ear
2	Press power button
3	Wait for phone to say "Registered" and ensure there is signal strength
4	Press "0" for approximately 2 seconds until a "+" appears
5	Dial number. Ensure that you dial 1 first For example +1 (780) 667 2310
